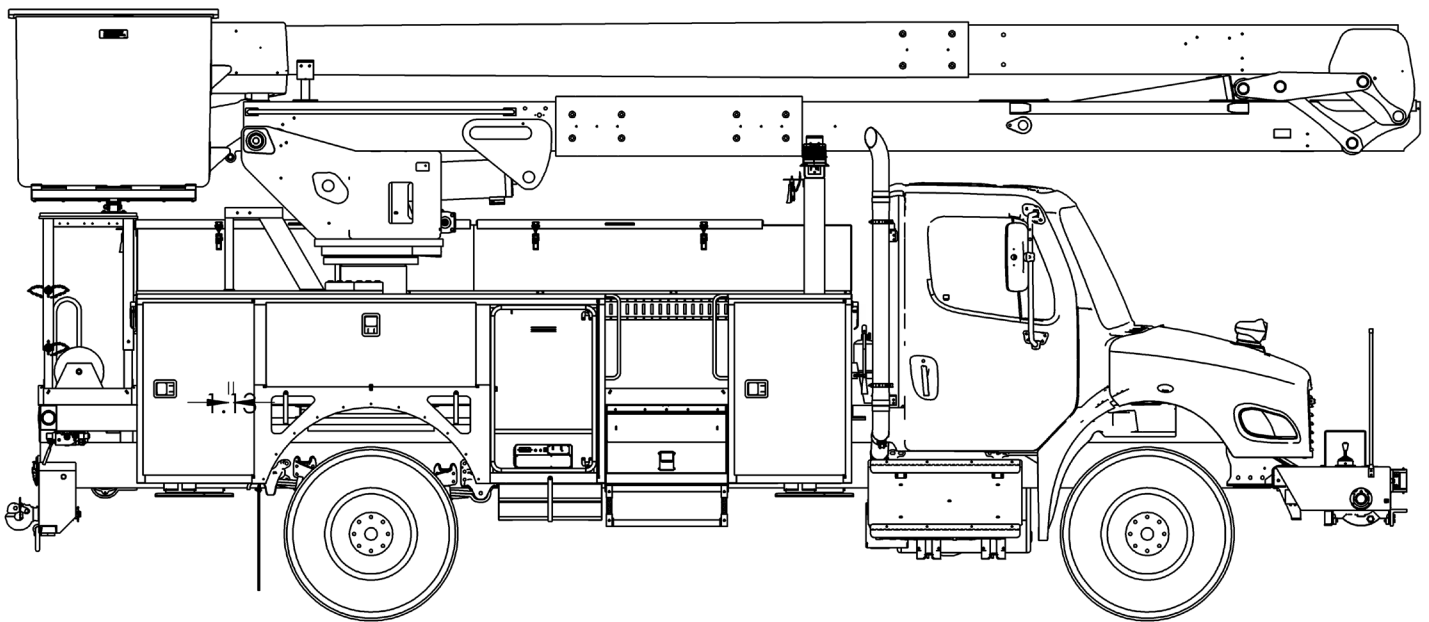

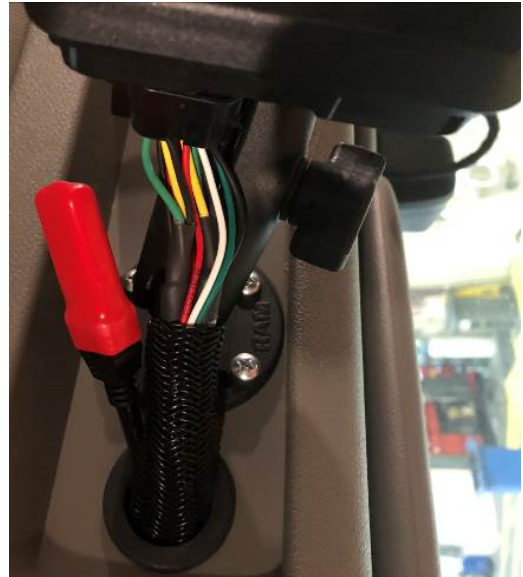
Exporting the Configuration File

STEP 1

Turn the ignition key ON and allow the screen to fully boot up.

STEP 2

Follow the wires from the back of the switch panel and locate the USB port. It should have a red dust cap on it. Remove the cap and insert the Flash drive.



STEP 3

Press the “Home/Select” button until “Settings” appears on the right-hand side of the screen. Press the “Settings” button.



STEP 4

Scroll through “Settings” until “Configuration Page” is available. Once highlighted, press the “Select” button.



STEP 5

Press “Print Config”, the light will flash green if the file is saved to the USB drive. If the light is red, try power cycling the screen or switch to a new flash drive.



STEP 6

Confirm that the file is saved on the flash drive.



Importing the Configuration File

STEP 1

Install the unit specific configuration file on an empty flash drive.



STEP 2

Press the “Home/Select” button until “Settings” appears on the right-hand side of the screen. Press the “Settings” button.



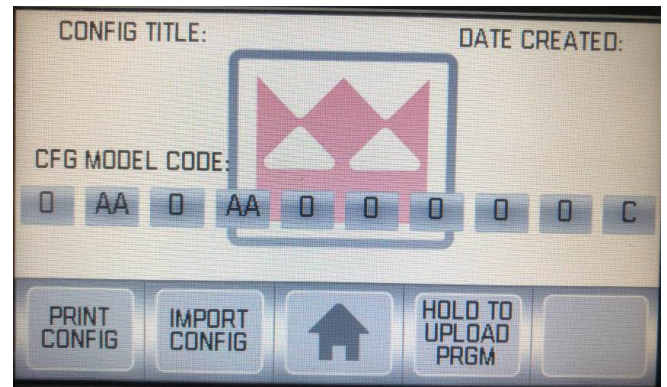
STEP 3

Scroll through “Settings” until “Configuration Page” is available. Once highlighted, press the “Select” button.



STEP 4

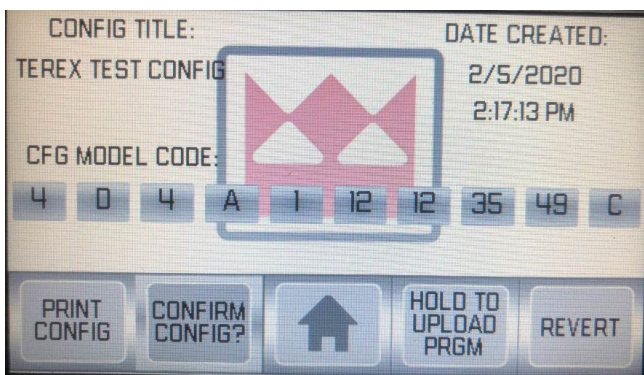
Press the “Import Config” button once.



STEP 5

Confirm the Config Title is correct. If correct press CONFIRM CONFIG and that will apply the config file.

STEP 6

Verify inputs, outputs, and button labels to verify everything is correct. Operate the unit through the full range of functions.
